### BLOWOUT RULES 2010

**A Main Division**, 10" Wheels, 2700 lbs, Tires allowed Hoosier 970s, Body rules: Max nose overhang 45", Rear Quarter overhang 48", Max body width 82" over the tires, 72" measured at rear spoiler, Spoiler to be 8" of material and 72" wide, 42" off the ground, and no verticals taller than 42" off the ground and no verticals can interfere with drivers side window opening or view. No wheel flares out past the outer edge of tires. If no roof is being run, arm restraints are mandatory. Also, No wings, radios or mirrors. All safety rules enforced, Aluminum Heads and or Dry Sumps must add 50 lbs.

**B Main Division**, 8" Wheels, 3000 lbs, Tires allowed Hoosier 8" treaded race tires only, 970s, 880s, 800s, 790s, and Comanches. No TDs, 700s, 650s, or recaps. 3 link rear suspensions must add 100 lbs, Headers, and or Aluminum Intake, and or 4 Barrel Carbs. Must add 100 lbs. Body Rules same as A Main Division.
